

The Battle of Armageddon

- ☞ This title can be a bit misleading.
 - ☞ Not a single battle, but will be a series of conflicts leading up to the Second Coming.
 - ☞ The conflict is not isolated to just the valley of Megiddo.

The Battle of Armageddon

- ☞ There is not a single passage that outlines the events of this battle.
- ☞ It seems that during the 42 months when Antichrist is ruler of the world that he will establish his headquarters in Jerusalem.

The Battle of Armageddon

- ☞ While the world leader, considerable unrest against his rule develops.
- ☞ The sixth bowl opens the way for armies from the east to challenge his authority.

The Battle of Armageddon

- ☞ As nations ready to battle nations, Christ appears and the nations unite to make war with Him.
- ☞ Rev. 19:11-21 indicate that the kings and armies are utterly crushed by the King of kings.

The Battle of Armageddon

☞ The Lord Jesus will seize the Antichrist and False prophet and throw them alive into the lake of fire (Rev. 19:20).




The Second Coming

- ☞ The six goals of Daniel 9:24 find their fulfillment.
- ☞ Salvation is brought to Israel (Matthew 23:39)
- ☞ Jesus reclaims the world for God.
- ☞ Believing Israel is regathered in the land of Israel.

The Second Coming

☞ Jesus is established as king (Rev. 19:16)



The Judgments at the 2nd Coming

- ☞ All Judgment has been given to Jesus Christ (John 5:21-23, 27).
- ☞ His eyes are like a flame of fire (Revelation 1:14, 2:18).
- ☞ He is Holy (Revelation 3:7).

The Judgment of the Gentiles

- ☞ Joel 3:1-2; Matthew 25:31-46 speaks of this judgment taking place near Jerusalem (Valley of Jehoshaphat).
- ☞ Those who are welcomed into Messiah's Kingdom are the "sheep" of Matthew 25.
- ☞ The unsaved are the "goats".

The Judgment of the Gentiles

- ☞ Gentiles are judged by the way in which they treated Israel during the Great Tribulation.
- ☞ Saved Gentiles will enter the Millennium in their early bodies and will be a part of the repopulating of the earth.
