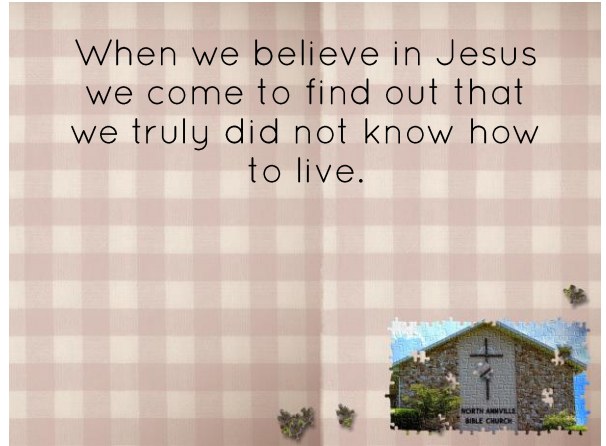
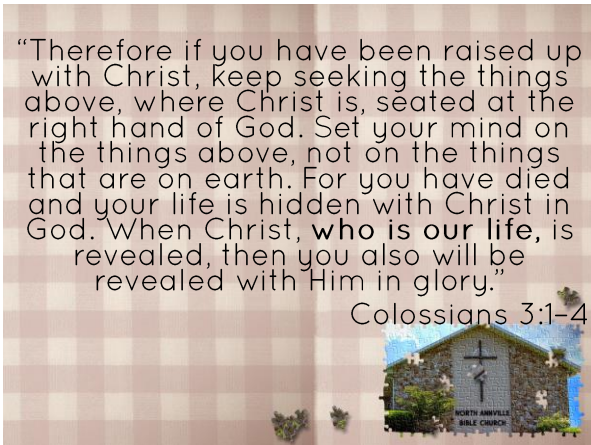


"You Will Not Like This"
1 Timothy 6:3-10

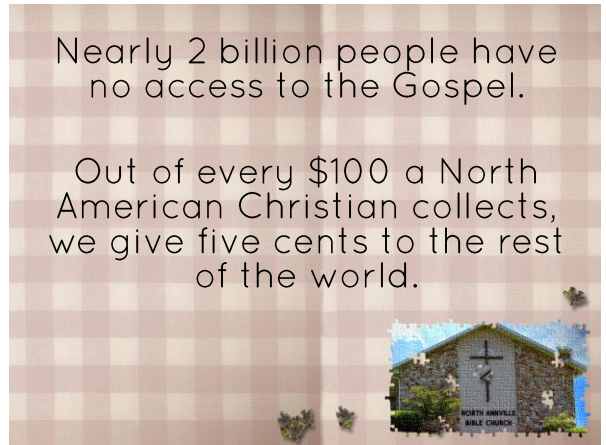


When we believe in Jesus
